We will use newspaper (or other black and white print), pens and pencils to make a tonal collage and look at how to interpret this as a blackwork embroidery.

Designs can be traditional or as creative as we want to be. Not a fan of black on white? Then other possibilities can be explored. Jill will make sure we have sufficient information from the day's workshop to complete the piece at home.
