

29 September -23 October: Exhibition at Forty Hall



Forty Hall is keen to help us celebrate our group's 40th anniversary year in 2022 and has invited us to mount an exhibition from 29 September to 23 October.

The title of the exhibition will be 'Seeing Red' with the subtitle, 'celebrating 40 years together'

We will have a display of panels on a red theme to reflect our ruby anniversary. Panels (25 x 25 cm) will be provided for members on which to mount the work. Any method or theme is acceptable but your piece must have some red in it! If your work is smaller than the panel then please cover your panel with red fabric (or paint) and mount your work on that.

As a member, you can take part in several ways:

- Completing a canvas for the 'Seeing Red' exhibition'. Canvases will be mounted in groups in a tile formation to be displayed in the second-floor corridor, with some hung around the staircase.
- Creating individual 3D pieces, inspired by room contents, to be displayed in the first and second floor rooms. These will lead up to our main group display. You can visit any time in normal opening hours to take photos or make sketches for inspiration.
- Taking part in 'meet the artist' sessions to demonstrate your work or engage with visitors.
- Helping visitors to make felt cacti, on Saturday 1 October, and chatting with them about our group.
- Helping to complete the crewel work embroidered panel for installation at Forty Hall and celebrating this group achievement as part of this commemorative month.

We really want everyone to participate, to demonstrate the variety of possibilities stitch and textiles can create, and to encourage new members to join us. So please be ready to join in, and show North London what we can do!
